






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Manzano Mesa




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Arroyo Del Oso




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Bandelier




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Sombra Del Monte




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Comanche

Outside or Inside = Sandia High School, 7801 Candelaria NE, 294-1511.




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North Star Elementary

Outside or Inside = Double Eagle Elementary, 8901 Lowell St NE, 857-0187




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Georgia O'Keeffe Elementary

Outside or Inside = Eisenhower Middle School, 11001 Camero Rd NE, 292-2530.




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Hubert H. Humphrey Elementary

Outside = Academy Hills Park; Inside = Eisenhower Middle School, 11001 Camero Ave NE, 292-2530.




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Osuna Elementary

Outside = Osuna ES Park; Inside = Hubert Humphrey, 9801 Academy Hills Dr. NE, 821-4981.




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Inez Elementary
