I want to have the power to fly so I could fly to school and not sit in traffic. If I was strong enough I could just pick up my mom's car

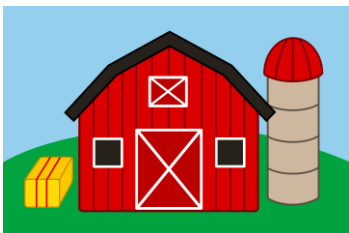

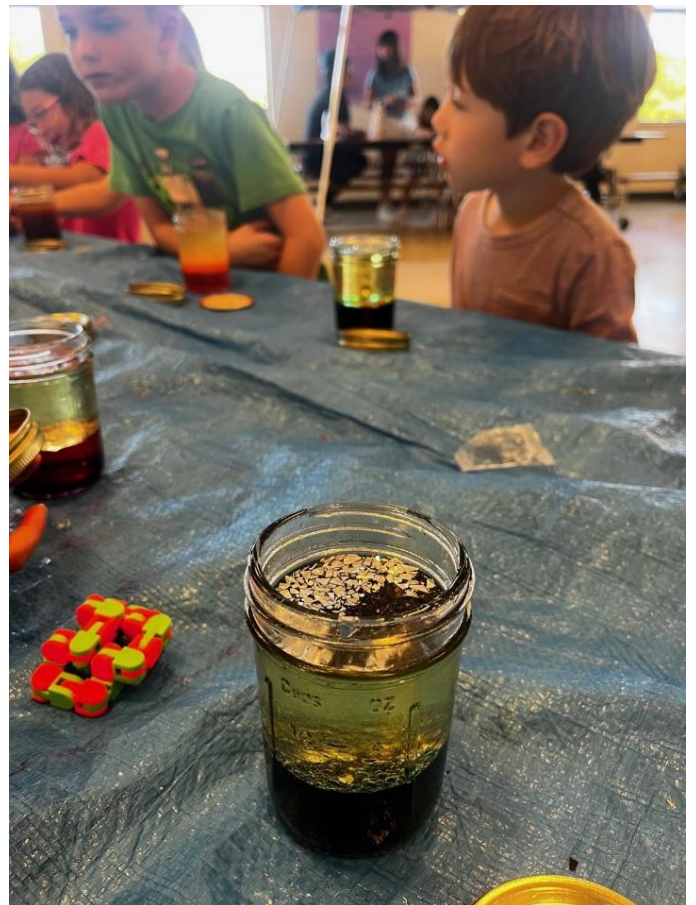
