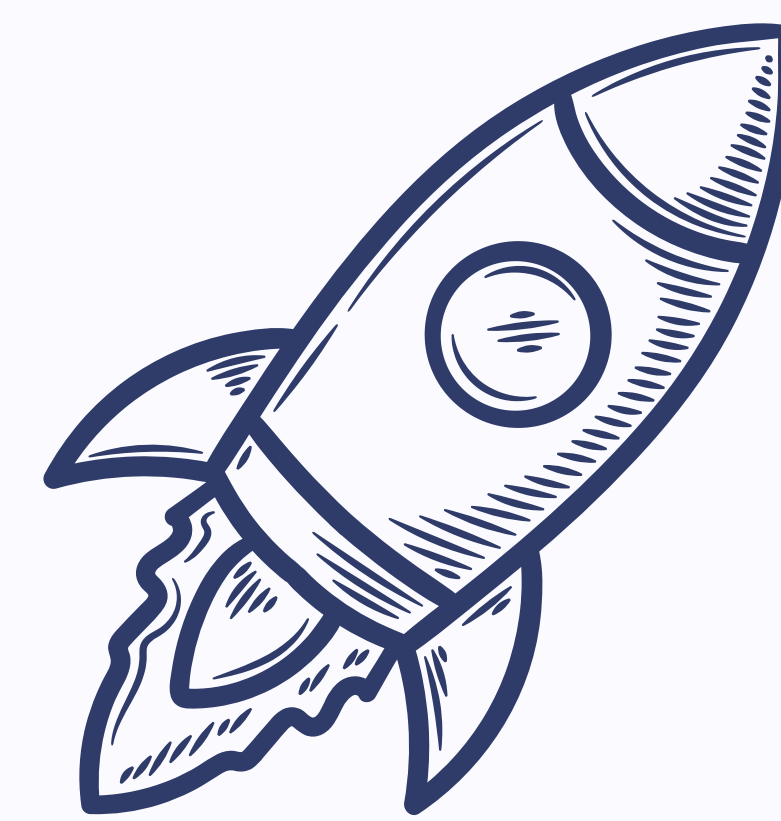

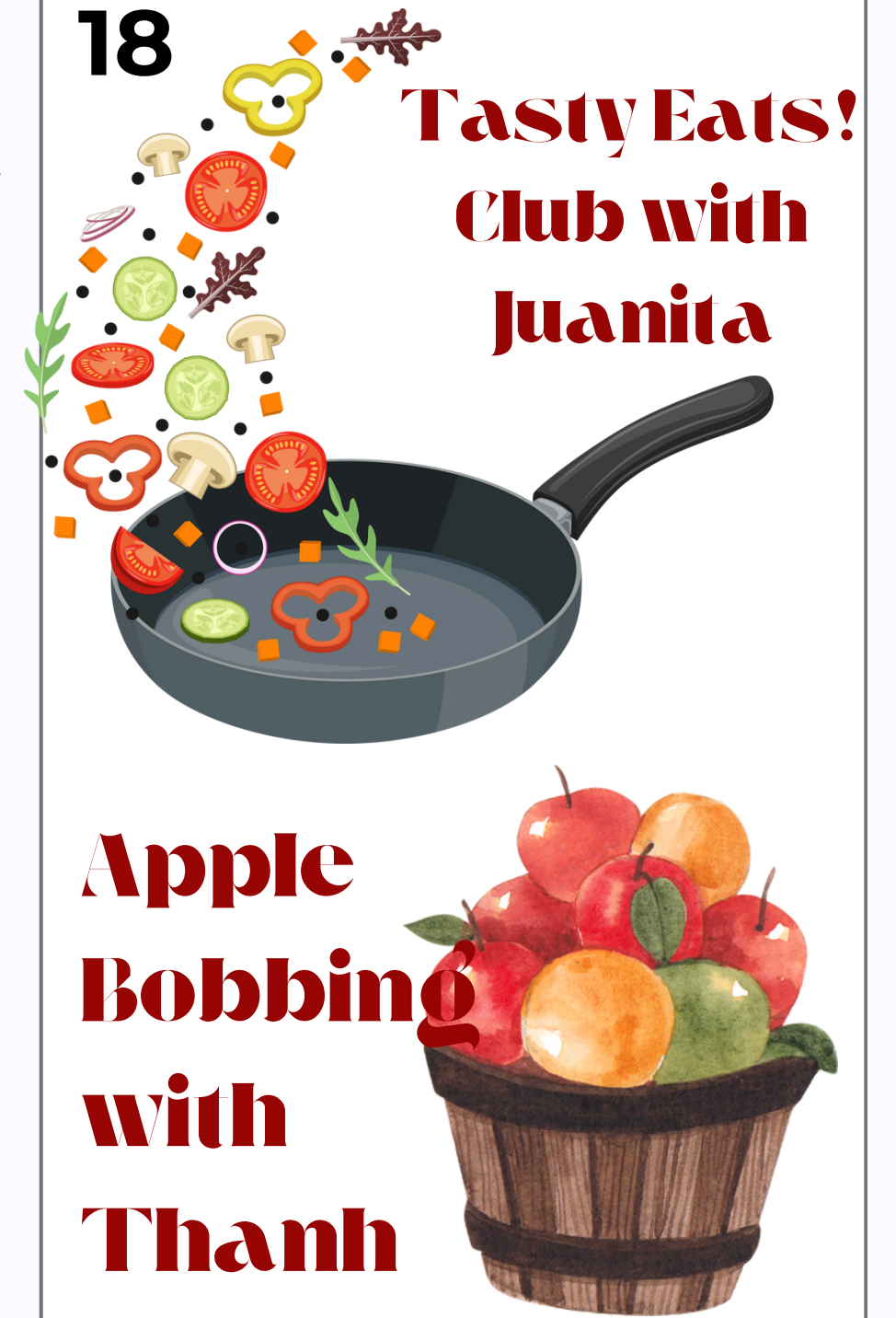

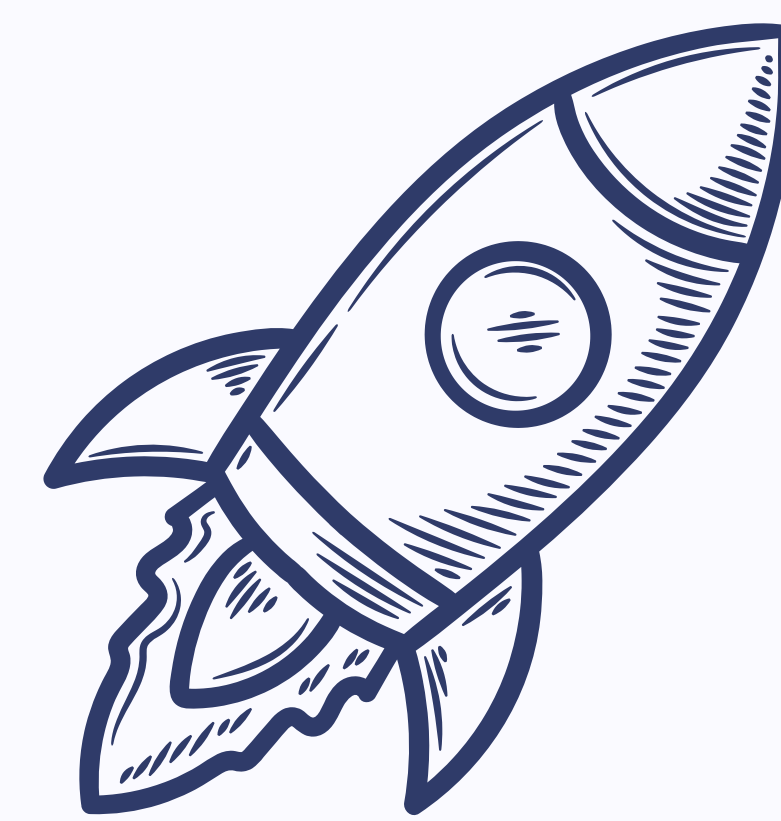

The scientists quickly understood the importance of each ingredient and the part that they played in the experiment.

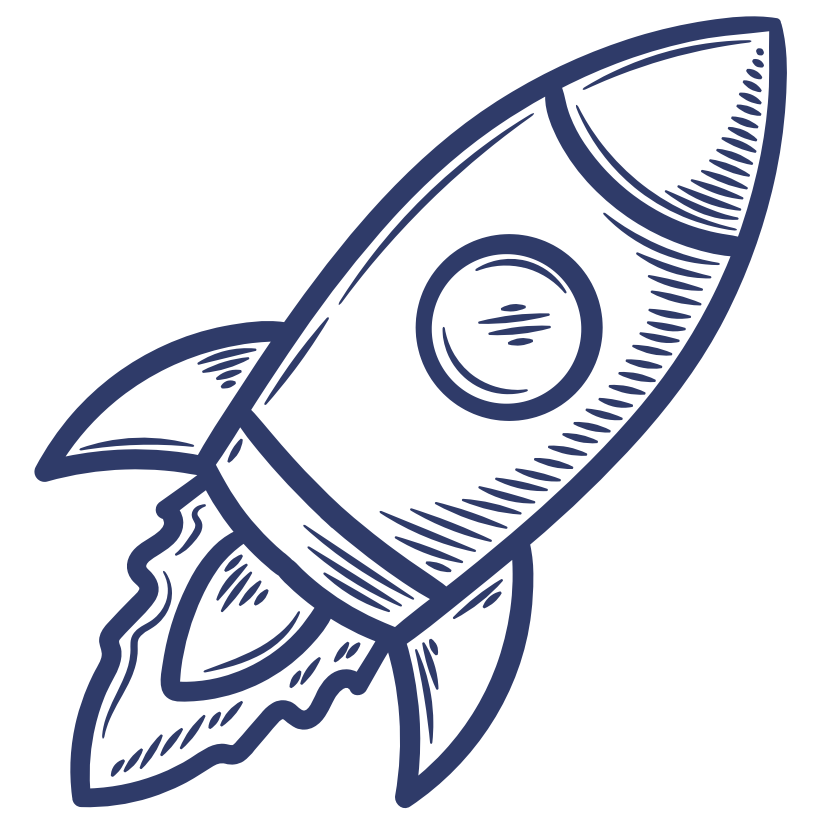
“I need to add more baking soda.” - Sebastian M. (6)

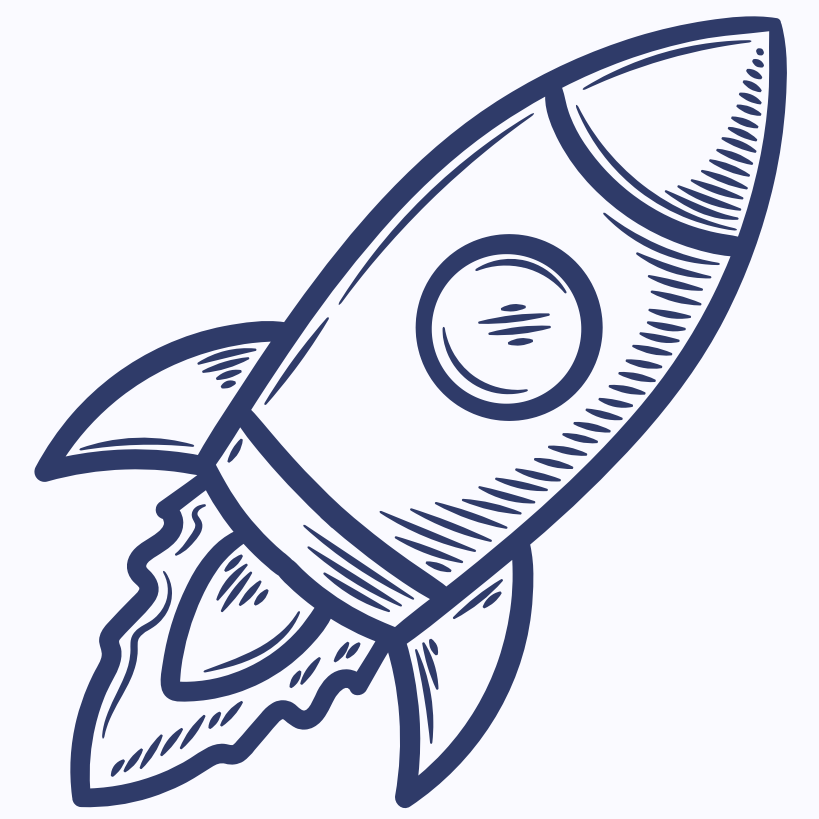
The “vegetable” day had club members make individual salads. They were able to choose what toppings they wanted to add *and* chop the vegetables along the way!
