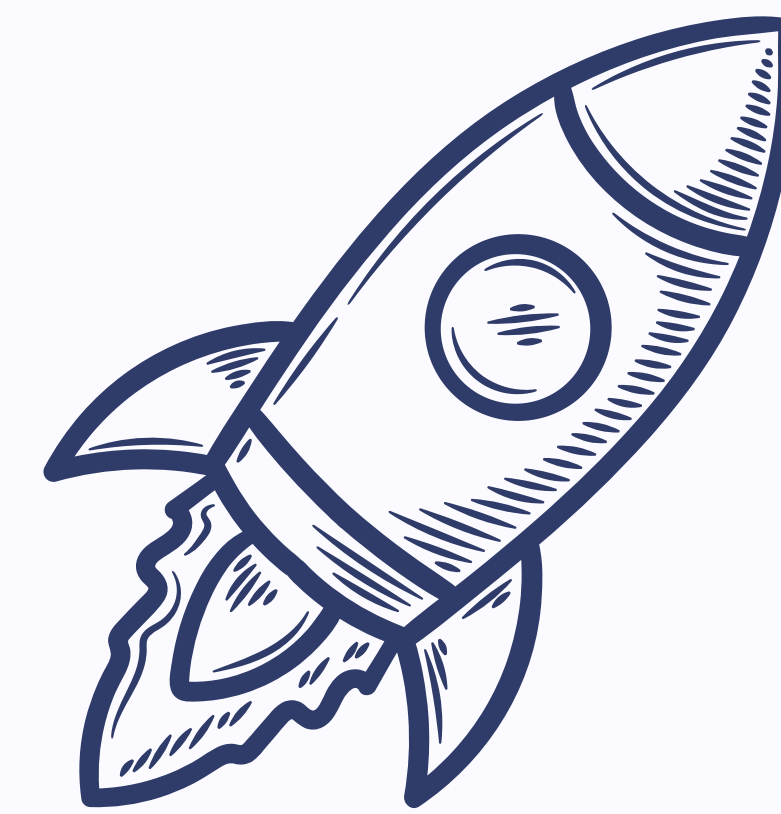

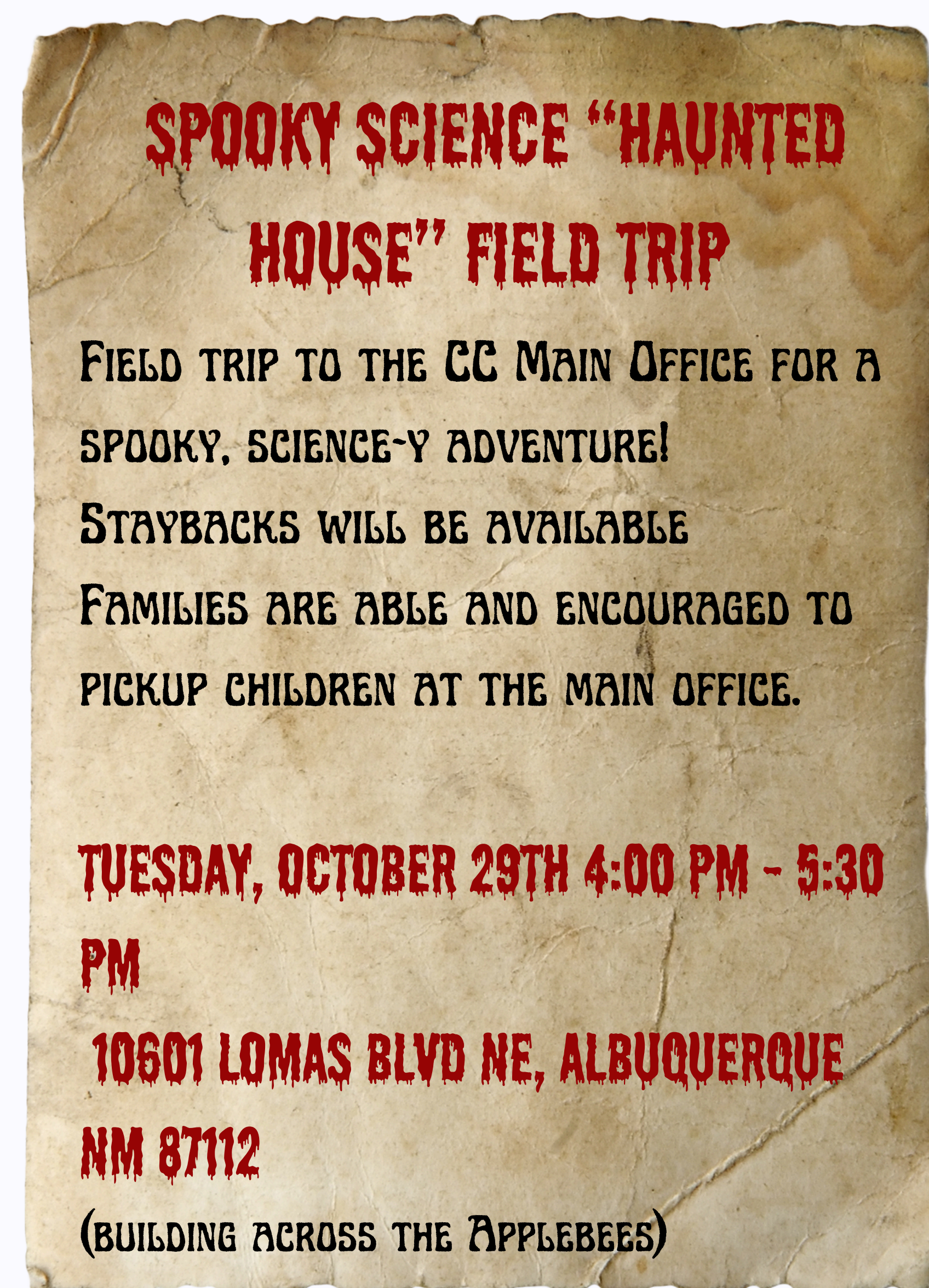


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### October 28th - November 8th , Announcements and Reminders!

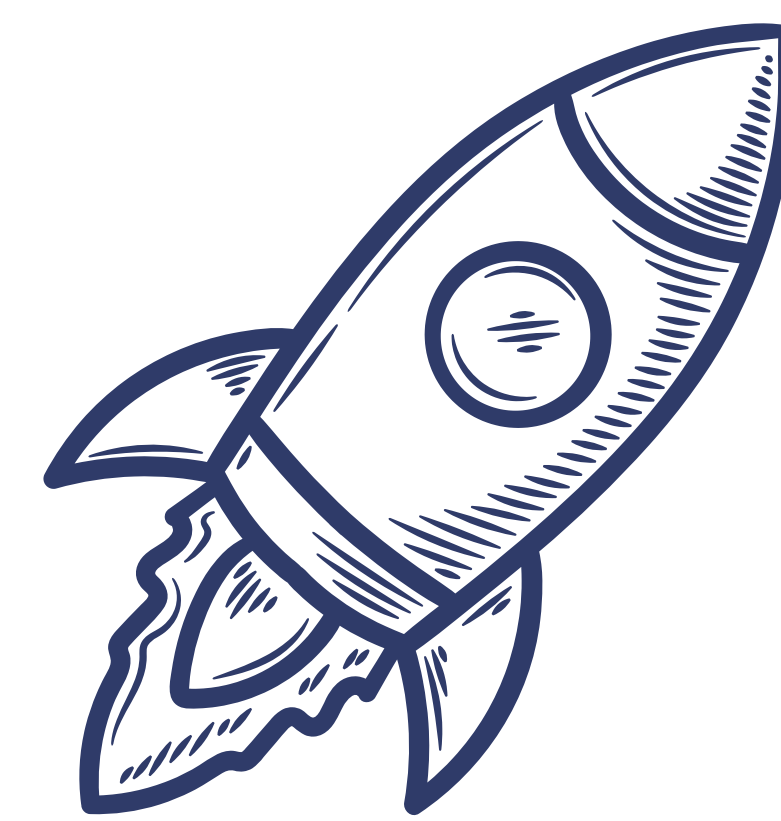
### "Fish Out of Water" Club with Matt

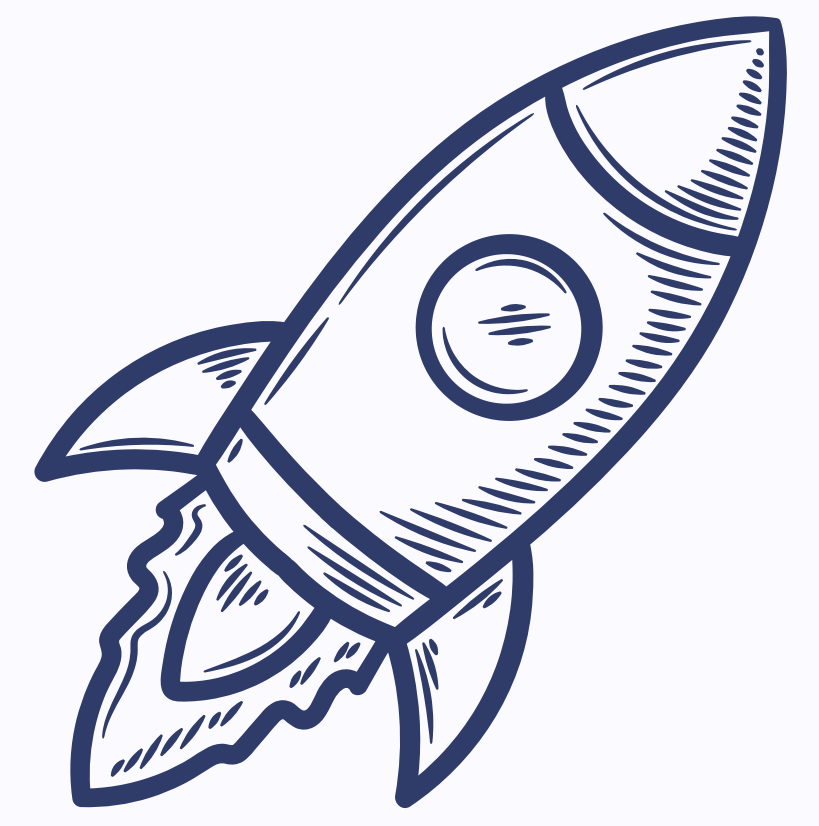
