If could have any super power what kind of superpower would you want?

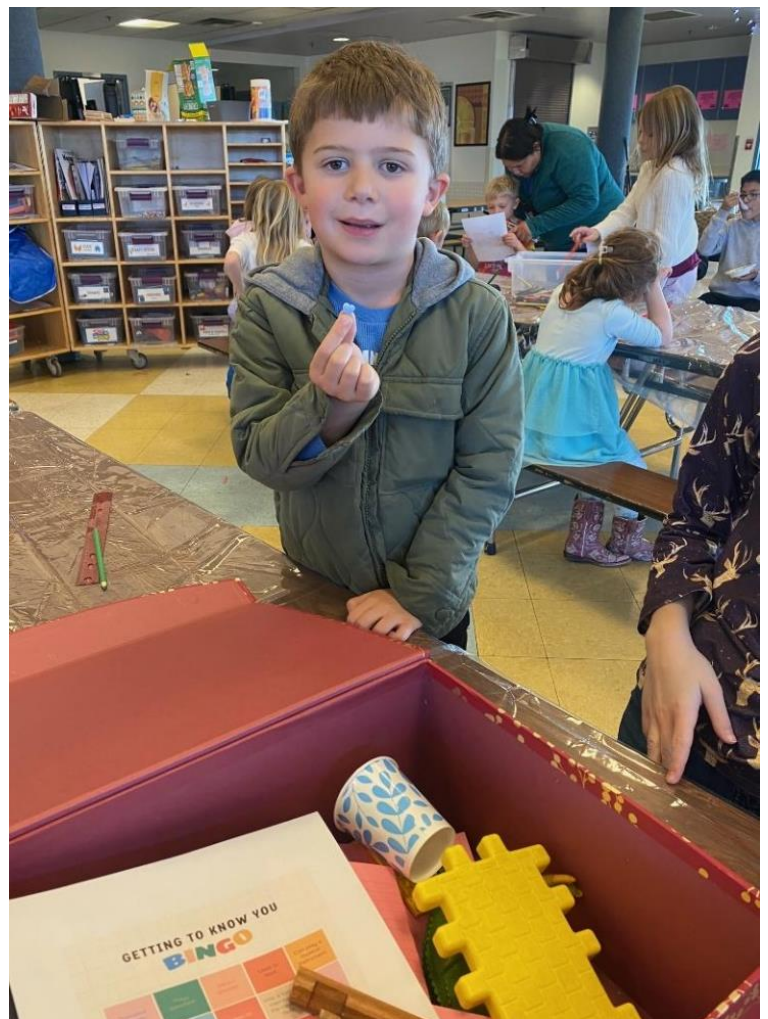
-I would want magical super powers and have a magical instrument like in D&D.
