






















IMPORTANT INFORMATION

Now that Damian has been an older kid for a couple years he has realized he enjoys helping out the community and the littles specifically. He wants to make our community better, stronger, and cleaner.


Damian is excited to go to middle school after this year so that he can meet new people and make new friends.
