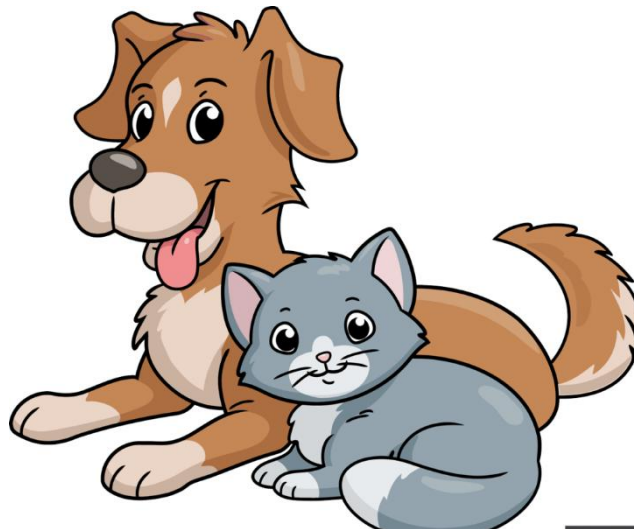
**February 17<sup>th</sup> Full Day at Double Eagle for Presidents Day**
