If you could change anything about CC what would you change?

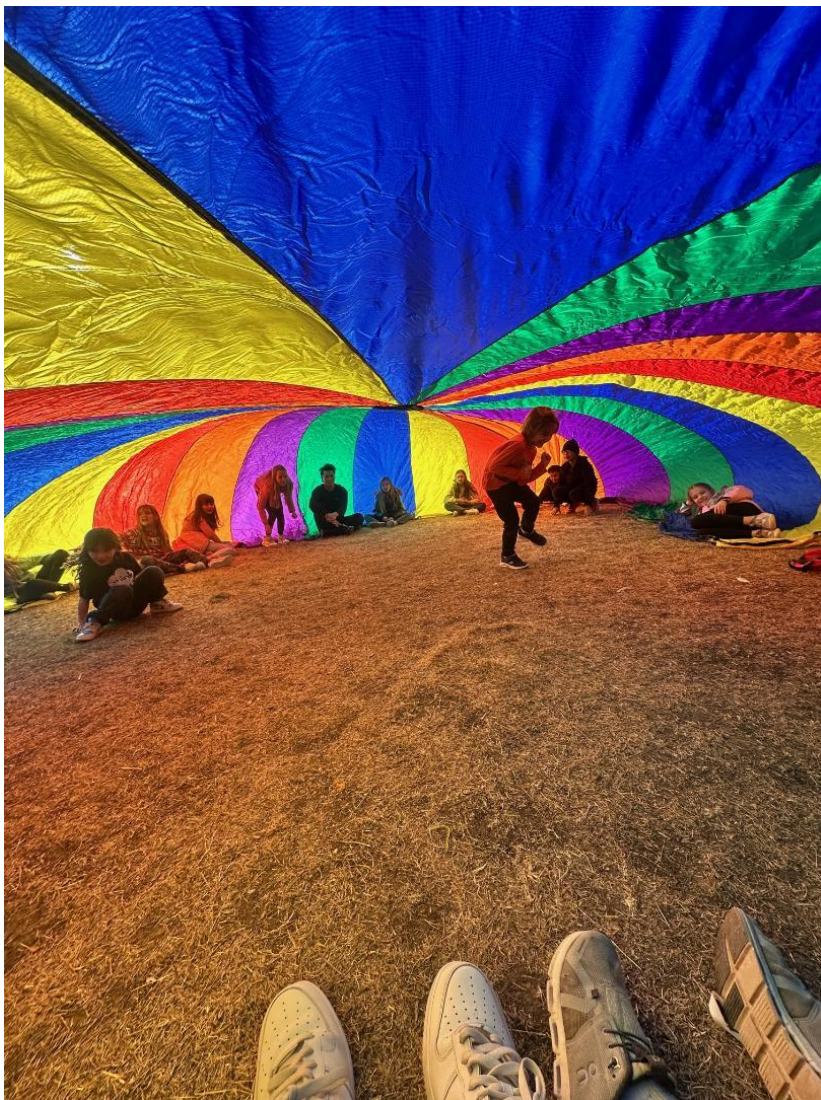
I would have time for screens and Minecraft.
