Activity members started by drawing their designs onto foam tiles to make a carving. Then, they used the rollers to apply ink to their tiles and press them onto their paper or tote bags. There were all kinds of designs made.

The older kids were given the special opportunity to carve their designs into a linoleum block. This proved to be a tricky technique, but worth it!










BINGO NIGHT THROWBACKS!

Bingo dabbers and stickers were placed all over the cafeteria for people to easily access and use.


The CC staff worked hard to find prizes that the whole family would enjoy. So, we went with prize kits that everyone could participate in!
