## CALLING ALL KINDERS

The goal of the Kinder Club is to teach the younger children how to use both their gross and fine motor skills. Along with giving kids confidence and support, this club helps students learn how to do things on their own. We studied the various kinds of slime this week! I asked them questions and helped them learn about measurements, textures, and following rules. They all took their time making their own bag of slime. I had two older kids help me out with the activity. What is it about slime?

It's a sensory material with a texture that's playful and stretchy, and encourages children to invent, build, sculpt, play, and even relax.
