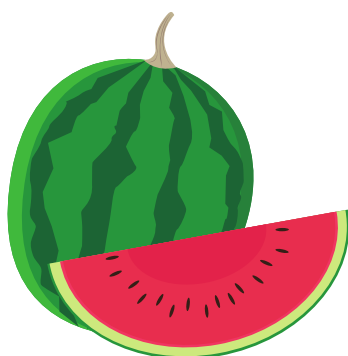

Cook & Create Club: Agua De Sandia



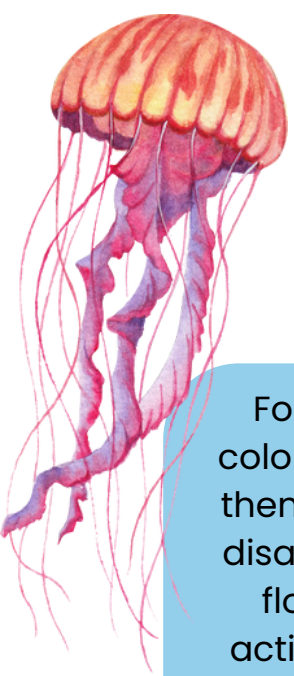

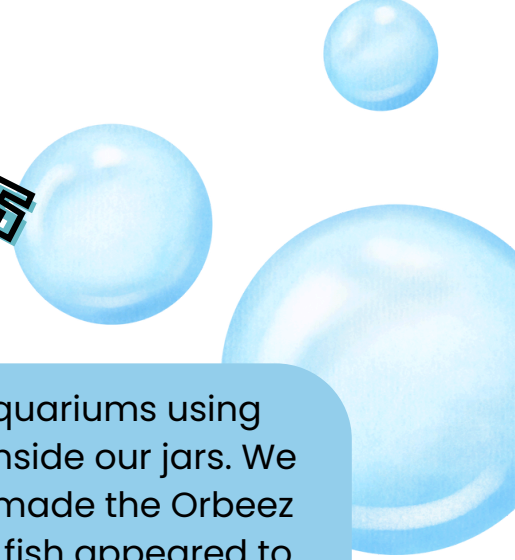
